Dale Cody is Senior Vice President at Metric Engineering. He joined Metric Engineering as the Director of Traffic Operations and ITS in Metric's Central Florida Office in 2002. He has "hands on" experience in all aspects of ITS and traffic signal systems communication, traffic engineering, traffic studies, corridor retiming, surveying and construction management. Over the past 5 years, Mr. Cody has managed or overseen more than 30 major ITS design, integration, and ITS CEI projects, totaling \$150 million in construction. He has experience retiming traffic signal systems using Naztec, Peek and Eagle closed loop software and controllers. This includes complete programming of the signal system components as well as debugging during the implementation process.
