# Broward County Metropolitan Planning Organization

## PROFILE

The Broward County MPO is a federally-required planning body responsible for transportation planning in Broward County.

Established in 1977 by the Florida Legislature, the MPO was created to direct urban transportation planning and allocate federal and state funds. It is the lead agency responsible for developing and administering plans and programs to maintain eligibility and receive funds for the transportation systems in Broward County.

Made up of government representatives who plan and recommend transportation project priorities, the MPO consists of nineteen members including representatives from local cities, the South Florida Regional Transportation Authority (SFRTA), the School Board of Broward County, and the Board of Broward County Commissioners.

The role of the MPO is to establish a comprehensive, coordinated, and continuing transportation system for Broward County. This is accomplished by: 1) developing a twenty-year Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) that will provide an efficient, multimodal transportation system for the county; 2) prioritizing projects for funding purposes in a five-year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and 3) creating an annual Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) that develops short-range strategies to implement the findings and recommendations of the LRTP and the TIP.

The Broward County MPO coordinates ITS project planning and development and integrates it within the area's overall transportation planning process. It also works closely with the South Florida Regional ITS Coalition to meet compliance requirements of the National and Regional ITS Architecture.
